### PRESCHOOL STORY TIME

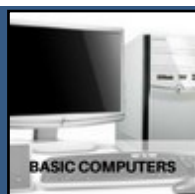
Come visit for fun stories and craft time led by our Children's Librarian, Ms. Kathy.

### BASIC COMPUTERS

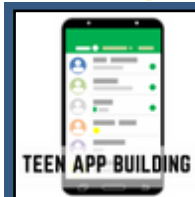
This is a beginner course for those that are new to using a computer. Various topics will be discussed about using a computer. This event is free and open to the public.

## ADULT



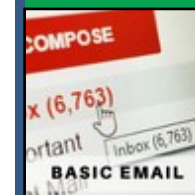
### BASIC WORD
